Liberti Church Main Line seeks to live, speak, and serve as the very presence of Jesus for Philadelphia's historic Main Line and its surrounding communities.

OBJECTIVE

The Worship and Music Director will be responsible for providing leadership, planning, and execution of Sunday Morning music. They will recruit and equip musicians to glorify God through facilitating the corporate worship of Liberti Church Main Line. We embrace a vibrant musical expression incorporating both traditional and contemporary sources. The role is a part time position (up to 20 hrs/week), with opportunity for increased role in the future.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Exercise consistent Christian integrity by striving toward the character descriptions of mature believers (Ps. 78:72; 1 Tim. 3:1-13; 4:6-16) and cultivating healthy spiritual and emotional rhythms of confession, repentance, prayer, and rest
- Exercise engagement in our local church community through becoming an In-Covenant member, participating in a Home Meeting (with household, if applicable), welcoming visitors, inviting others into the church community, and contributing financially to the work of the church.
- Participate in the church's mission by living in or near our Main Line community, pursuing and developing
 intentional relationships with friends and neighbors, sharing the Gospel with non-Christians, and practicing
 informal hospitality and generosity.
- Be skilled in both instrumental and vocal direction.
- Be able to proficiently play an instrument in a worship band (ex: keyboard, guitar).
- Have a quality singing voice and engaging stage presence.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist the Lead Pastor in developing the vision, goals, and strategic plan for Sunday morning worship services and other special services.
- Prepare and lead corporate worship through music and other relevant liturgical elements on Sunday mornings.
- Lead rehearsals and coordinate rehearsal schedules with members of the band.
- Develop, utilize, and maintain a wide repertoire of songs, musical pieces, and liturgical resources.
- Assist in the generation of the weekly worship folder by providing the songs/lyrics that relate to the theme
 of each Sunday service and applicable liturgy elements.
- Build and train a roster of qualified musicians to participate in weekly services.
- Identify, grow, and develop new worship leaders from within the congregation so that over time he/she can lead worship on a rotating basis (or at another worship site).
- Recruit and schedule volunteers for the Worship Team on Planning Center Services in collaboration with the Administrative Assistant.
- Assist the Media Team Director in troubleshooting problems related to both music and sound.
- Meet regularly one-on-one with the Lead Pastor.
- Attend Liberti network leadership development events.
- Timely submission of expense reports to the Administrative Assistant.
